You evidently haven't a clue of the extent he suffered. They spit in His face and beat Him with their bare hands first, all the while mocking Him. He was flogged with what they call a "cat of nine tails"; it's a whip with shards of glass, and rough metal and stone, and lead balls in the tips. This whip literally tears off chunks of flesh. Afterwards, they wrapped up a branch of thorns into a crown, and pushed it into His skull. (Many

historians say that the thorns used were typically 4 inches long, sometimes longer, and that they'd take a stone and hammer the thorns into the person's head. Keep in mind that Jesus was being treated as any criminal sentenced to death would be, so there are many other historical records depicting the regular dealings with criminals, and some of the irregular dealings, thus further confirming what Jesus went through.) They mocked Him more, and then forced Him to carry His cross. The cross was normally rough-cut and extremely heavy (well, for someone that's already half dead by that time). With the size of it, I would estimate it was somewhere between 100 and 200 pounds. As the person carrying the heavy cross walked, large splinters would dig into their back and shoulder. Jesus had been flogged not too long before this, so those splinters were digging deep into his wounds. To make matters worse, the soldiers would push and kick the criminals during their walk up to Golgotha, so that pushed splinters even further in. When they reached the top of the hill, they laid the criminals down on the cross, and drove extremely long nails into the wrists (they considered that as part of the hands), and the upper portion of the feet (both feet held by a single nail), and stood up the crosses. The nails were driven into the hands and feet in a spot where the criminal couldn't fall off the cross. If the nail was driven into the palm of the hand, there would only be flesh holding them to the cross, and with all of their weight on it, they'd just fall off, the nail tearing out right between two fingers. The wrist isn't as easily torn, as there are many bones holding everything together. Also, where the nails were placed, there's lots of nerves, so it was extremely painful, and any movement made it worse. Add to that, the fact that their physical endurance had already been extinguished by flogging and carrying the cross up the hill. They're out of breath and in extreme pain. Usually, they'd leave their entire body limp, hanging by their hands, but that severely limited their lung capacity, so they'd have to occasionally straighten their legs (exerting force on the nail in their feet, thus causing a great deal of pain there), take a deep breath, and let their legs go again (placing the weight on the hands again, causing more pain). The up and down worked even more splinters into their back.

The flogging started somewhere early in the morning, possibly 7am or 8am. The crucifixion was around 9am or 10am. At noon, the sky went dark for 3 hours, as Jesus took the sins of everyone upon Him. Shortly after that, Jesus said his last words on the cross, and "gave up the ghost". All the sins of the world were not only covered, but washed, with the blood of the pure Lamb. At that moment, the veil in the temple was torn in two, since now Jesus is our High Priest who intercedes on our behalf, to the Father.
