Hi All,

One of my services is killed when i log off from my Win XP/2000 machine, i.e., it is removed from the list of running processes in the Task Manager . It needs to be restarted manually again after a login.

I did some investigation and found that this was due to the "CTRL\_LOGOFF\_EVENT" passed by the JVM(<http://java.sun.com/j2se/1.3/docs/tooldocs/win32/java.html>). It further said to use the `-Xrs` option to ignore such events.

Can someone please tell me how to use this option correctly? Its really urgent, and I am currently at my wits end,so any help would be greatly appreciated.
