> *I have an ADO connection that is connected to the same ODBC entry that
> Sql Explorer is using and logging. And yet, when it is used in my app,
> nothing gets logged to Sql monitor.*

>

> *case 1:*

> *Sql Explorer app -> BDE -> Native driver doesn't get logged*

> *case 2:*

> *Sql Explorer app -> BDE -> ODBC gets logged*

> *case 3:*

> *My Delphi app -> ADO -> ODBC doesn't get logged.*

Case 1 and 2 works fine for me (BDE->Native MSSQL driver and ODBC). DBDemos didn't work, but it is a desktop db. I could only guess the SQL is handled internally and the table-based commands passed directly to the driver (nothing for the SQL Monitor to monitor) or Borland hid those details on purpose.

> *But, in the end, it doesn't seem to log the Sql activity from an ADO to
> ODBC connection which is the functionality I need.*
