Hi all.

I am currently experimenting with converting a quite large app from BDE to ADO. It accesses a MS SQL 2000 database, and before I commit and jump headlong into this I wonder if there are any major issues to be aware of? One of the main benefits I am hoping for is better multi-user detection capability e.g. if one user changes a record another has open and then the other user tries to change they get an appropriate error message. I have found BDE support for this a little flakey at best. Are there any setting changes from the default on TAdoQuery or TAdoConnection that I should definitely make? Finally I have seen a fair bit of discussion around suggesting that ADO will slow my app down, is this true?
