```
Select *
From Customer FOR XML AUTO
Where CustomerID = 19934590
```

But how do I get the results in my program?

without knowing what RDBMS you use (not sure what FOR XML AUTO is either) any select statement will return a set of records, and you can have it loaded into a TADOQuery or TADODataset without problems using a TADOConnection to connect to the database, assigning the command to your dataset and executing it.
