```
with ADOQuery1 do begin
  Sql.Text:=
  'select Column2 ' +
  'from Table ' +
  'where Column1 = '#39'THREAT_EVENTS'#39;
```

Open;

```
// Exception: Parameter Column1 has no default value;
```

I tested that query. I get an error "syntax error in from clause" which is because Table is a reserved word changing that to [Table] fixes that error
