How many records in this table, are there any blobs, do you experience same problem with server side cursor?

280,000 records No blobs. Not tried with server side cursor.
Not even really sure what that is:) But there is no "server" in this scenario, unless you call JET a server.

Take a look at CursorLocation property of TADODataset in online help. 280.000 records is pretty much, if you will open them with clUseClient, ctStatic cursor (default settings of TADODataset) it could take a lot of time and memory, since all this records will be fetched in memory.
