Raise the error level in your RaiesError

What i don't understand is why the same errorlevel causes an exception to throw in one case but not in the other.

My guess is the TadoConnection.Execute does not have its errors directed into the Errors collection so all errors are surfaced.

or check the TadoConnection.Errors collection for the error you are generating.
