Error message:

"Server: Msg 170, Level 15, State 1, Line 3  
Line 3: Incorrect syntax near 'Fr'."

When the error occurs, Delphi generates an exception  
(EDatabaseError),  
which gives me only a message "Line 3: Incorrect syntax near 'om'."
