It is the current number.

- > Is there a way to know how many of the blocks allocated (and maybe since
- > freed) by the applications are classes (vs being string, array, etc.),
- > maybe with the debug/leak trace info?

There is a function to determine the class inside a block, but it is not declared in the interface section. It is used by the memory leak report.
