> *I did that, and I found that it complained 3 files were missing, and then  
ignoring that hoping it would be something that wouldnt matter, you run it  
and it complains that xmlrtl90.bpl is missing.. Removing all references I  
could find to that file didnt help either.*

> *In the end the only work round I found was to copy the xmlrtl70.bpl off a  
machine and renamed it to xmlrtl90.bpl and tada it started.. doesnt exactly  
fill me with confidence though.*

Actually, it sounds like the "start-up" mechanism just needs to check that  
file off of its list. Presumably, if the IDE attempts to actually load it  
it will blow up.

Allen Bauer explained that he has implemented "on-demand" loading of  
packages in his blog, so that would explain why it didn't blow up  
immediately.

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
