Norton especially qualifies more as a "virus nest" IME, I've seen more than one machine "protected" by an up-to-date Norton, that would be revealed as a host to hundreds of species of viruses and worms once you ran an AVG scan on it...

And it is almost impossible to get Norton OFF of a system once installed!!!

Symantec has some cleaner utilities hidden away in their support are (at least when i last looked) which worked fine for me. Using the normal uninstall is as good as deleting the folder ;)
