One major problem still exists however.... turn off JavaScript in your browser and try to load the site. Blank
page....

I don't know if this holds true for the apps that Morfik creates, but if even the web site does not work without
JS enabled, that is pretty bad. Not least of all from an SEO point of view – since to Google, www.morfik.com
is now an empty site (in fact, Google only shows 4 pages on [morfik.com](http://www.morfik.com) to be indexed, and 3 of them are old
and no longer exist).

In some cases it's not unreasonable to have a web app that requires JS – for example, on a company intranet, a
content management system etc. However I think on **any** application and particularly web site that is 'front
facing' (that is, to the general public), requiring JS is unacceptable.

That's the problem with AJAX... it is a great technology don't get me wrong, but too many people get caught
up with the pretty effects and don't think of the possible problems with it (accessibility, mobile browsers,
older browsers, high security policies etc).
