> using v1.40) It contains the TSMWeatherInfo component mentioned by Mike S
> in the previous post. If I read the website correctly, you feed it a zip
> code and it gives the temperature info from weather.com. For \$35 including
> source you also get TSMInfoExtractor which will let you parse the HTML.
> You also get a couple of routines for automatic updates, a news 'pusher'
> and a whizzy component that talks to UPS so your users can plan their
> route, send themselves a postcard and see where the postcard is within the
> UPS delivery system. ;-))
