With a quick glance on your code, I see:

> *ResultSet rs = stmt.executeUpdate(...);*

executeUpdate doesn't return a ResultSet and it shouldn't.

It returns an int with either the row count for INSERT, UPDATE or DELETE statements, or 0 for SQL statements that return nothing.
