*>I have to use JAI to support the widest possible range of image formats. The
>approach you suggest does not work with formats other than GIF, JPEG and
>PNG. E.g. for BMP images the BufferedImage returned from ImageIO is null.*

Reader-writer plug-ins are supplied for the BMP, JPEG, JPEG 2000, PNG, PNM, Raw, TIFF, and WBMP image formats. The supplied streams and associated service providers use the New I/O APIs.
