I set it to the lowest security and privacy and took off the XP firewall and that didn't help either. I never had to set a proxy before and I kind of know what it is, but since it all worked without me typing things in before, I was thinking it should keep on working. I must be mad. I can work around one of the applets, and not see what I'm posting to Ebay, and take longer to do it, but the other applet, I can't do certain functions at all. I can't see maps or tax data. Did I say I uninstalled and reinstalled Java from the Sun site twice and made a noble attempt to make sure I had the latest ActiveX from MS?
