>JRE1.5.0_05 is not fully supported for 64 bit system yet.
>
>JDK1.4.2_10 more than likely is. Sometimes the newest version is not
>always the best version to intall. From experience using JRE1.5.0 on
>SuSE Linux a few years ago (Yeah, JRE1.5.0 is not as new as you think
>it is.), I learned that the older version is much better.
>
>The best suggestion I would offer is to uninstall JRE1.5.0 and stick
>with JDK1.4.2 until SUN can get enough clients who have JRE1.5.0.
>

The only older version I could find was 1.4.2_6 which does not have amd64 version of the library. Plugin of libjavaplugin_oji.so into 64bit mozilla of firefox does not seem to be working.

What libjavaplugin_oji.so do you use?
