

How do I pass a Text field value from one JFrame1 to JFrame2

I have been trying to solve this for the past 4 hours, so any pointers would be helpful.

Problem: I have jTextField1 in JFrame1. When I call JFrame2 from JFrame1 using "new JFrame2().setVisible(true);" command, I need to retain the String value of JFrame1(jTextField1) in JFrame 2.

I tried creating a class called 'Global', and a public String variable 'a' within it.

1. I set Global.a = jTextField1.getText() from within JFrame1
2. JFrame2 is able to read and print the value of Global.a properly.

But, when I try this function, it's getting caught in the if statement – if (Global.a == "abc") {... }

What are my options for passing JFrame1(jTextField1) value to JFrame2, so I can display that in the new form.
