I don't mean to start any flames or such. I work at a company where I'm the only Java programmer and the rest are developing in CF. This is for inhouse intranet applications. Some of the management is trying to switch development over to Java. I was hired on and part of my job is to help transition them over. While I have nothing against CF, it appears that there is a huge resistance. I'm using Struts, JSP and Servlets. Here is what I'm faced with:

What kind of application are you developing? Is it possible that the resisting programmers are right? If the application is a lot of front end and very little business logic, then you might justifiably have a hard time convincing anyone to switch. If they are not right, though, then you'll be able to find things that are very awkward or difficult in the existing CF application, and suggest alternatives.
