1099 by default.

what about if 1099 already in used?

It shouldn't be because it is reserved by IANA for the RMI Registry. So if it's in use it **should** mean that the RMI Registry is already running.

what significant difference between A & B?

The significant difference is that A starts the registry on port

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'defport' and B assumes it is already running on port 1099.
