X03 | X05 | X07

X04 | X02 | X08

X01 | X06 | X09

In the diagram above as 'X' is any character and the remaining one is a subscript (01, 02, 03 and so on..). What I want to do then is write the character to the screen in the subscript order X01, X02 and so on..
