Hi,

I am trying to run Eclipse 3.1.1 on an HPUX machine (uname -a = B.11.11, 9000/800 which I assume means I am running OS 11 on an HPUX 9000 machine) and I am using a 1.4 JVM. When I start Eclipse it hangs on any window/wizard/dialog box that requires input. For example if I start Eclipse with no parameters, the workspace window appears where I choose my workspace directory. I cannot input any data or select OK, or anything. I am stuck there and need to kill everything.

If I run Eclipse with the -d option then it goes to the normal Eclipse start window. Everything looks fine, but again I cannot select anything, click on anything or use any menu. Also, the progress bar that shows up while starting never quite finishes. There do not seem to be any logs created that I can find.

I am running Cygwin from my laptop to connect to the remote HP Machine and I am using ssh -Y to start the window/session.

Is there any trick to getting Eclipse to work on an HPUX machine?
