In my opinion, a downhill slide started when MacroMedia took it over. Now that Adobe has it, I have visions of my web pages taking as long to load as Adobe and with just as much overhead.

Therefore I have a sense that I should seriously look at PHP. Can anyone advise a good source (web site or book) that would help me make the transition. Any advice would be appreciated.
