I have a php page I am writing with an SQL query. I am going to query the database for a couple of fields. One of the fields I am querying is the title oh the document someone is searching for. The title will be used at the top of the html page and will say:

"you are searching for document number ###: document \$title"

but then later on down on the page when it starts returning your results:

"document \$title: document \$location"

So I will have 1 query that needs to print the document \$title at the top of the page and then when it starts showing results. I won't know what the document title is until the database is queried (because they are doing a query for keywords in the documents stored in that table in the database). So at the top of the page can I use my \$title from the database and then when I start showing the results, can I show the same document \$title from the 1st row returned if I am using a while loop, or because I already used \$title at the top from the 1st row returned, will it want to start at the 2nd row returned when I start my while loop to return all of the data?
