this is the query command
\$query = 'SELECT *
FROM `job listing`
WHERE open >=\$today
LIMIT 0 , 30 ';

I have assigned \$today this way \$today=date("Y-m-d");

Can you tell me what I did wrong??

Sure! =)

You must scape your PHP variables in any SQL query...

Try this:

```
$query="SELECT *  
FROM `joblisting`  
WHERE open >= '$today'  
LIMIT 0,30";
```
