- > *file, and display that via a Web page. PHP doesn't appear up to the*
- > *task (but it can get/set Linux permissions OK).*

- > *Can Perl handle this? I thought Filesys::SmbClient might work, but*
- > *the docs imply Linux permissions can be changed, not the Windows side.*
