For an EXE, one approach is to create a shortcut (I believe making a PIF file will also work, but haven't tried that) and modify the Options tab under Properties, in a way that will be obvious when you get there...

Did you know that switching to full-screen requires a mere "Alt+Enter", however? Maybe you don't need to force it there to begin with.
