Tried to install Win extensions, but have forgotten how it's done. Clicking on setup in the Win Extsions package flashes a window by, but cannot read it. and I don't see a way to load the setup into Python without Win Extensions.

I would recommend using the command line. Open that up and then type something like this:

```
python pathToWinExt\setup.py
```

That should run it and when it's done, your command window should stay open. Hopefully it will tell you what happened.

Since I don't have Vista and don't know if it will recognize the name "python", you may need to specify a path to it too.
