I'm using python + django to do some web design and I would really like to use the python image library as part of this. There seems to be a problem, however, with apache and mod_python being 64 bit while my python image library(PIL) is only 32 bit.

Does anyone have experience with building the correct architectures so that OS X 10.5 plays nicely? I think, when it comes down to it, I just need PIL at this point to be x86_64 so that it plays with apache and mod_python.
