Weird – thinking back, I think I've found the opposite to be much more common – apps delivered by vendors, etc. with dynamic libraries or even ones built in house, but with one machine at a different set of patches than others, resulting in the app requiring shared libraries of specific versions that don't exist elsewhere. Whereas with statically linked apps, things seem to work.

Of course, in BOTH cases, one has to be careful not to compile for instance something on Solaris 9 and then try to run it on Solaris 8.
