Is it possible either with core tcl or an extension to copy an image from a tk application to the Windows clipboard? If it is possible, can anyone give me a concrete example?

I want to be able for a user to do a copy/paste operation of an image between my tk app and a Windows app such as powerpoint.

I'm not looking for any other mechanism to get images into a Windows app; I specifically want to be able to put images onto the system

clipboard.

I think TWAPI is the way to go
<http://twapi.sourceforge.net/> looks like you just need to lookup the format code for images of your desired type.
