Hello,

the exec command returns the output of the program. Like this:

```
image create photo -data [exec import -window root gif:-]
```

The output of the program is binary data and the image is wrong. The above command works if the format is xpm (7 bit ascii). I assume the output of the command is converted to utf-8. The following snippet works correctly:

```
set f [open "|import -window root gif:-" r]
fconfigure $f -translation binary
image create photo -data [read $f]
close $f
```

Is there any way to get the exec way work?

Something like "exec -translation binary ..."
