::WS::Client::GetAndParseWsdI does not take a proxy, the third argument is an alias to use (only really useful if you do the stubs creation).

If you type into a web browser, <http://cdaweb.gsfc.nasa.gov/WS/jaxrpc?WSDL> do you see a WSDL come up (I do)?

Yes, per my previous [near-simultaneous to yours] post. Do I not worry about the "key "service" not known in dictionary" response? When I invoke it from the command line I just get that simple reply but when I ran it from a script file there were several other lines of debug info that made it seem like a messy crash.
